Definition of Terms:

Variable-fixed: there is a new market-based interest rate with each new loan, but that rate is then locked for the life of the loan. Variable: the interest rate would vary each year based on the market-rate.

Fixed: the interest rate is set at a pre-determined rate and remains locked for the life of the loan
